☆ **FACTS ABOUT TRAIL ROTARY** ☆

Rotarians, be proud of your local accomplishments.

I was intrigued with George Swanson's talk several weeks ago when he reviewed the current status of the Shavers Bench Villa. Thorpe Watson explained to me the practice of Rotary initiating important community projects, then turning them over to Societies to operate and manage. Listed here are key projects with important dates. Many thanks to three excellent club historians for their knowledge and their interest in helping me: George Swanson, Thorpe Watson and Cliff Krauss for his excellent record keeping.

☆ **SHIVERS BENCH VILLA**

(Current Chair George Swanson)

- 1952 - Rotary offered 9 Shavers Bench lots to the Senior Citizens Villa Society
- 1958 - The Villa was completed October 16, 1958 - 23 suites (13 one-bedroom & 10 bachelor suites)

☆ **KIRO MANOR**

(taken Over By Interior Health)

- 1962 - The Rotary and Kiwanis Clubs initiated a joint project to build KIRO under the direction of the Trail Senior Citizens Lodge Society ("TSCL Society")
- 1968 - KIRO Manor - started construction
- 1969 - KIRO Manor opened July 4 - 40 personal care beds (9 staff)
- 1976 - KIRO Manor expanded to 84 beds, including 27 intermediate care beds
- 1997 - Upon dissolution of the TSCL Society on April 1, KIRO Manor came under the direction of the Community Health Council

☆ **JUBILEE PLACE**

(Current Chair - Ed Nichols)

- 1979 - Work began on the project to build Jubilee Place under the direction of the Trail Elderly Citizens Housing Society
- 1982 - Jubilee Place opened at 1651 Bay Avenue in October with 35 one-bedroom suites
