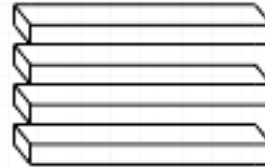

District 5080 Governor Sandra Roberts Visits

Before taking office the District Governor-Nominee and the District Governor-elect are trained at the International as well as at the Regional level. During this 3 year training period Governors plan and direct a Club Presidents-elect, Leadership Workshops for District Committee Leaders and District Assemblies for Rotary club leaders.

The District Governor is an officer of Rotary International. In that role Governors have specific duties to perform to ensure that the quality of Rotary does not falter in the District. They set the tone so that the District operates as an ethical business organization much as any CEO of an organization does.

Governors oversee the entire district by providing leadership and support to clubs and Rotarians. They appoint qualified Rotarians to serve as Assistant Governors, District Committee Members, and District Trainers. They are also responsible for all financial aspects of the District.

The responsibility for all District Programs resides with the District Governor, such as Group Study Exchange, Youth Exchange, Rotary Youth Leadership Award, Interact and Rotaract.

In District 5080 we have 60 Rotary Clubs, the District Governor will make at least one visit per club during the term of office. **District Governor Sandra Roberts will be visiting our Club on July 20th. She is the District's first women Governor.**

2005-2006 RI President Carl-Wilhelm Stenhammar said, "it is time to expand the role of women in Rotary. He pointed to the appointments of three past District Governors, Carolyn E. Jones, District 5010, as a trustee of The Rotary Foundation, the first woman appointed to the Trustees, the other two PDG's were appointed as chair of the new Public Image Resource Group and Chair of the Literacy Resource Group.

He also said (and I quote) "Please remember that it is through their talent, not their gender, that these women have earned their appointments.

EVER LOCK YOUR KEYS IN THE CAR?
